CALL TO ORDER / INVOCATION / LUNCH (*catered by “Olive Garden”*)

Rev. Al Anderson, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 1:01pm.

(There was a quorum with 14 members present.)

Mr. Tom Landry, JCPC Board Member, began the meeting in prayer.

I. STUDENT PRESENTATIONS FROM JCPC FUNDED PROGRAMS

(May 2022 expense report from Teen Court was emailed to council on 6-8-22. Reports were not received from MOCEDC at the time of this meeting.)

The following students were asked to attend and share their experiences with the programs they are enrolled in:

Adrian from the RTS Mentoring program

Eric from the YES Community Service program

Leroy from the Hoke County Teen Court program

Some of them answered direct questions from the council members. One of them read his apology letter written to a classmate. Everyone present was appreciative of the students' willingness to speak publicly.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Rev. Al Anderson, Chairperson, asked if the board members reviewed the minutes from the 5-18-22 meeting and if there was a motion to approve them as written.

Ronald Flippin motioned to approve the 5-18-22 JCPC minutes with any necessary corrections.

Gwendolyn Quick seconded his motion. All were in favor.

III. JCPC COORDINATOR'S REPORT

Lorraine Landry, JCPC Coordinator, reported on the following:

Administration Budget FY 2021-22 Update –

(A current balance sheet was sent out to board members on 6-8-22.)

Each line item will be spent down as close to “zero” as possible, if not already. The remaining balance is expected to be less than \$20 out of the \$9,700 budget.

IV. SUB-COMMITTEE REPORTS

Membership & Nominating Committee – Gwendolyn Quick, Committee Chairperson, distributed Certificates of Appreciation to all council members present and a small gift was given to each also *(printed Mason jars w/office supplies inside)*.

Then, regarding the election of new JCPC Officers for FY 2022-23, Gwendolyn Quick reported that her committee has received two nominations for Chair and Vice Chair:

1. Linda Revels for Chair and Darell McMillan for Vice Chair
2. Rev. Anderson for Chair and Linda Revels for Vice Chair (same as current year)

She opened the floor for any additional nominations. There were none. Linda Revels declined the nomination for Chair for FY 2022-23. In an opening for discussion, Tom Landry asked Linda Revels if she was willing to serve as Chair. She stated that she does not wish to be JCPC Chair.

Gwendolyn Quick asked if there was a motion to close the nominations.

Linda Revels motioned to close the nominations.

Ronald Flippin seconded the motion.

All were in favor.

Gwendolyn Quick asked if there was a motion to approve keeping the JCPC Officers the same; Rev. Al Anderson as Chair and Linda Revels as Vice Chair.

James Leach motioned to suspend the rule and to move with the current slate.

Tom Landry seconded the motion.

All were in favor.

Lorraine Landry, JCPC Coordinator, pointed out that this board action is contingent upon the Board of Commissioners' approval of renewing 12 council members for another 2-year term at their next meeting on 6-20-22, including Rev. Anderson and Linda Revels' terms. She will notify the council of the Commissioners' vote.

V. AREA CONSULTANT'S REPORT

Mrs. Kelly Cribb, NC DPS Area Consultant, updated the council on the following:

Restoring Youth Training - available virtually in the fall; someone possibly will give a 15-min presentation to us

Final Accounting FY 21-22 - deadline is for all DocuSign signatures is 9-1-22, but she encouraged programs not to wait; NC ALLIES is already opened for FA submissions.

Consultant's Monitoring – MOCEDC was monitored by the state and the files all looked good and met DPS requirements.

Recurring Funds for DPS - \$1,000,000 has been requested by DPS to fight gun violence; more information to come
